PERFORMING CREATIVE & ARTS

- Accelerated Dance students, Luciana Lopez, Sascha MacDonald and Melanie Wearing in Year 11, were nominated for *CallBack*; a selection of outstanding performances and projects from HSC Dance students to be held at the Seymour Centre, University of Sydney. All three students were nominated for both their Core Composition and their Major Study Performance – a very rare event indeed. The judges ultimately selected Luciana and Sascha’s Major Study Performances for inclusion in *CallBack*.
- Caitlyn Burton and Harry Vasey were both nominated for inclusion in *Intech*, the annual exhibition of outstanding Major Projects by HSC Industrial Technology (Multimedia) students. Caitlyn produced a website and an immersive short film installation to raise awareness of mental health issues. Harry produced a short film, using ‘claymation’, with an accompanying website. Harry’s Major Project was, in fact selected by the judges for display in the exhibition.
- From Visual Arts, two Major Works were selected for the *Express Yourself* Exhibition, these being Georgia Peter’s watercolour and Ben Shelley’s drawing work.
