

OXFORD FALLS GRAMMAR YEAR 7 2025 ENTRY

Academic Scholarship and Extension Program Eligibility

The Oxford Falls Grammar (OFG) Board provides scholarships for students of outstanding academic ability entering Year 7 in 2025. These scholarships are open to current OFG Junior School students and external students. Scholarships are tenable to Year 12 and can cover 100% or 50% of tuition fees, provided that recipients continue to meet the scholarship criteria.

OFG has a robust academic program and a contemporary focus on learning. Our educational strategies focus on the individual student, fostering critical thinking, curiosity and a love of learning. Each student's learning experience is rich, challenging and promotes his or her intellectual, social, emotional and spiritual growth. OFG offers extensive co-curricular activities along with leadership opportunities. Students are encouraged to take advantage of programs such as music, dance and sport.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Scholarship recipients demonstrate an ongoing, exemplary approach to learning and a high level of academic performance and engagement. They are committed to participation in areas of the school co-curricular program that align with their strengths, particularly enrichment opportunities, and demonstrate consistently high standards of citizenship. All scholarships are provided up to and including Year 12 and cover at least 50% of tuition fees, provided that the recipients continue to meet the scholarship criteria. If the scholarship holder leaves Oxford Falls Grammar prior to the completion of the Year 12 course, and subsequently re-enrol at another school within a 30km radius, you will be required to make a full repayment, equivalent to the amount of the scholarship, back to Oxford Falls Grammar.

CAMINO (EXTENSION) PROGRAM

The Camino Program is OFG's Gifted & Talented Extension Program. Students involved in the program encounter complex, abstract and challenging learning experiences, both independently and in collaboration with like-minded peers. They work to solve problems and investigate ideas deeply, creatively and reflectively, both within and across subject areas. Excellent results in the Scholarship Test may lead to students being offered early entry to the Camino Program. However, undertaking the Scholarship Test is **not** a prerequisite for entry to the Camino Program.

- Complete the registration form and pay the \$110 application fee
- Sit the Scholarship exam held at OFG on Saturday 17 February 2024
- Potential scholarship recipients will be invited for an interview with the Principal or Head of Senior School
- Entry to the OFG Year 7 Camino Program may be offered as part of the selection process
